



Veterinary inspection for bulls entered for Society sales

All bulls forward for Society sales will be inspected on the sale premises by a qualified veterinary surgeon appointed by the Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society. Any bull which does not, in the opinion of the veterinary surgeon, meet the following requirements, will be excluded from the sale.

The opinion of the examining veterinary surgeon is final.

Teeth

The teeth must make proper contact with the dental pad of the upper jaw and the lower jaw must not be severely undershot or overshot.

Testicles

The circumference of the bull's testicles must be measured at the widest point of the scrotum and must attain the following measurements:

- Bulls over twelve months but under 18 months – 32 cms
- Bulls over 18 months but under 24 months – 34 cms
- Bulls over 24 months – 35 cms

The testicles must also be of equal size with normal conformation and consistency.

General health

The bull must be in good general health and free from active infections or contagious disease.
